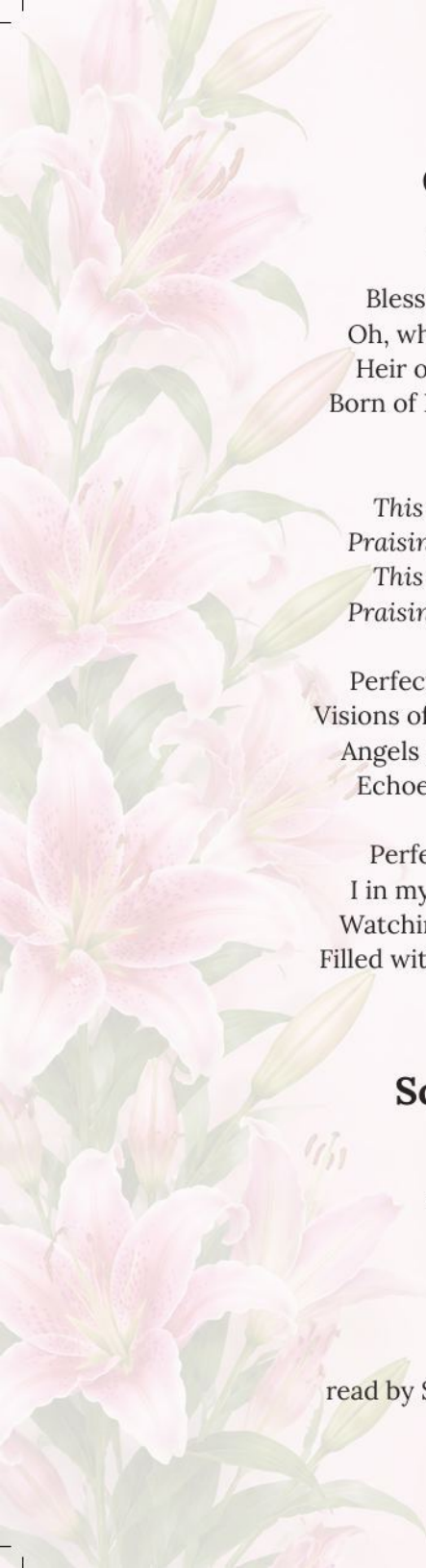

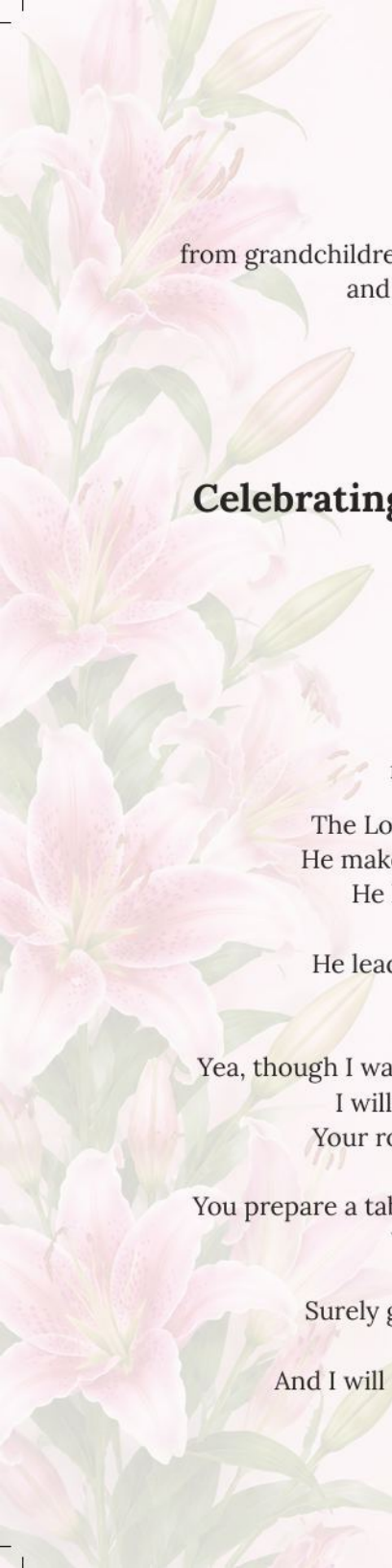

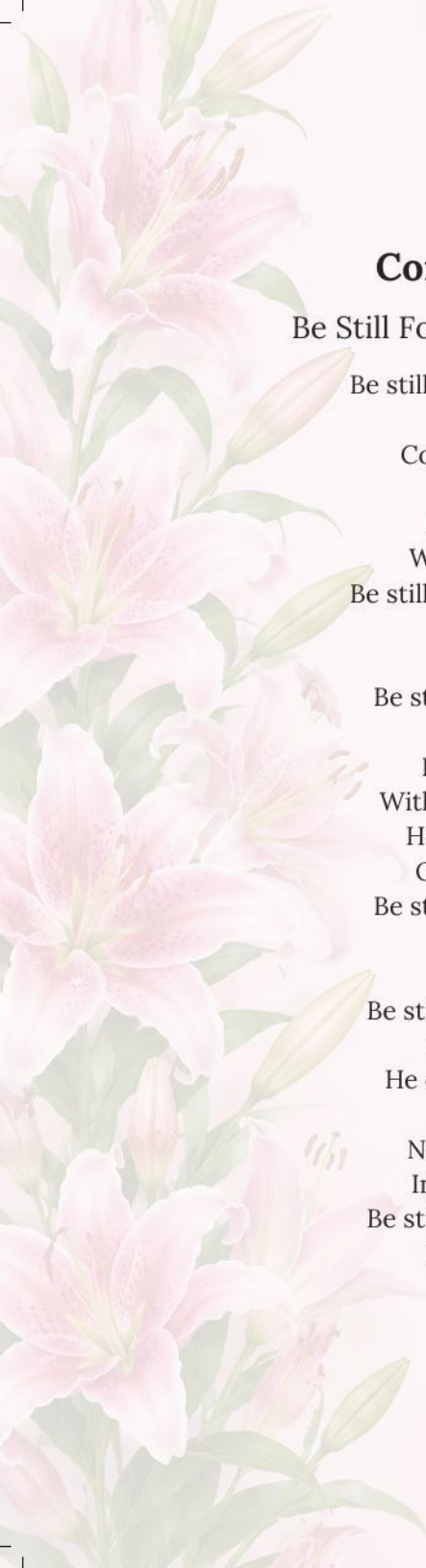
Psalm 23

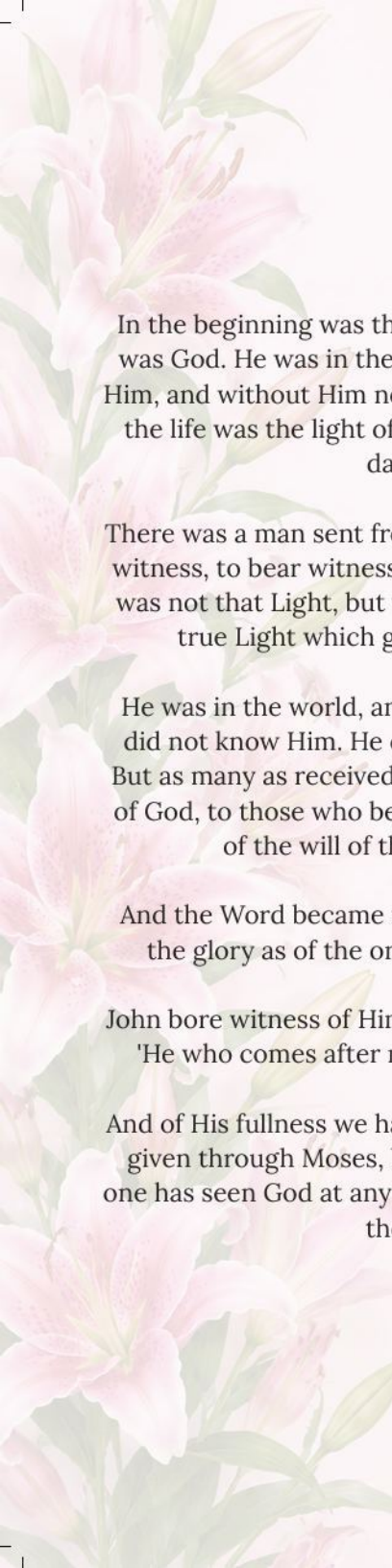
Be Still For The Presence Of The Lord

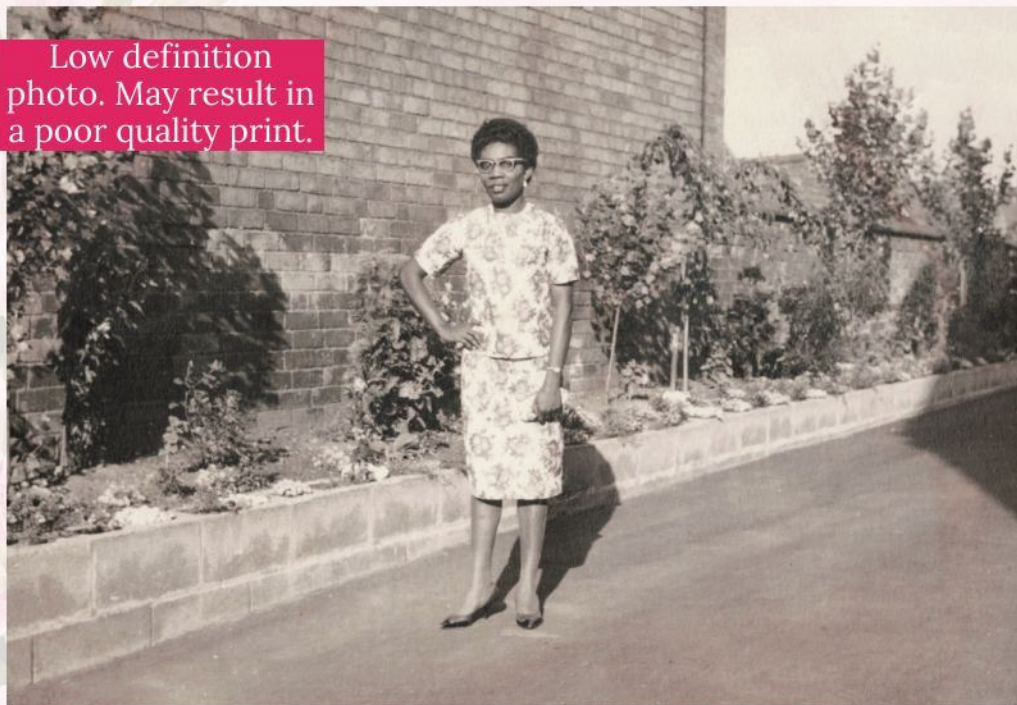
